Following acts amount to INDISCIPLINE in the college premises:

1. Ragging or bullying of junior students by the senior students.
2. Not being punctual to college.
3. Not wearing college ID Card
4. Bunking classes when regular lectures are going on.
5. Objectionable actions on the part of girl(s) or boy(s).
6. Chewing of tobacco, gutka, pan masala.
7. Entering/coming to college in intoxicated state.
8. Carrying or consumption of Alcoholic liquor in college premises.
9. Causing harm or damage to college property.
10. Usage of foul language either with peers or with teachers.
11. Not adhering to the proper dress code.
12. Using mobile phones in class.
13. Indulging in physical spats.
14. Inappropriate body gestures or verbal abuses.
15. Stealing.
16. Spitting in college premises (classrooms, staircase, corridors)
17. Causing disturbances in class.
18. Any other act of misbehaviour that disturbs the normal working of the college.
