

Report on Non-Violence Week

As per the circular from University of Mumbai, 2 October 2021 to 7 October 2021 should be celebrated as Non - Violence Week in every College. Cultural committee of Sanpada College of Commerce and Technology has organized two competitions for students in online mode. Along with the circular we received a pledge in Marathi.
